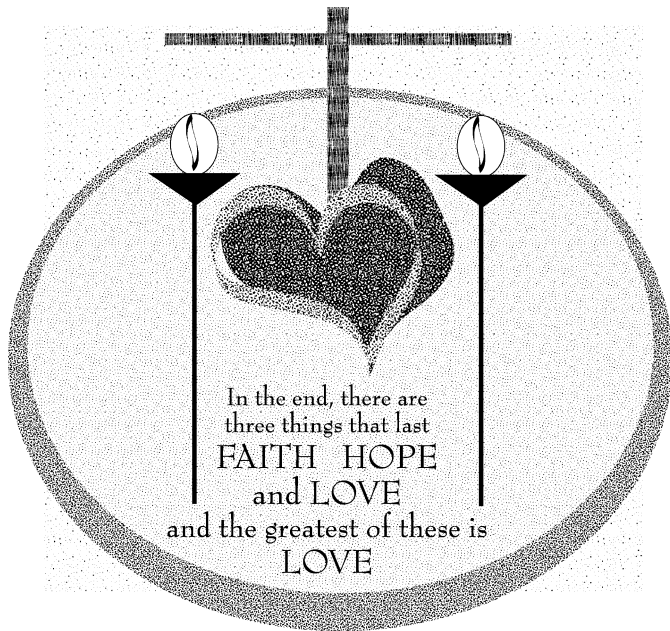


**Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Reflection on the Scriptures**

"There are in the end three things that last: faith, hope, and love, and the greatest of these is love." —1 Corinthians 13:13

If we have not love, we are nothing (1 Corinthians 13:2). If we have not love, our best efforts are useless (1 Corinthians 13:3). "The man without love has known nothing of God, for God is Love" (1 John 4:8). "The man who does not love is among the living dead" (1 John 3:14). Life without love is death. We must have love.

To love, we must realize the necessity of love and its impossibility by human powers. Then we will ask the Lord to give us the miracle of love. He will do this by loving us first (1 John 4:19) and purifying us through obedience to the truth (1 Peter 1:22). Love is the fruit of a great, multi-faceted work of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22). He graces us with faith, virtue, discernment, self-control, perseverance, piety, care for our brothers and sisters, and finally love (2 Peter 1:5-7). Love is a miracle resulting from a series of miracles. To act from a heart of love, that is, charity, is also a miracle. To love is divine.

Ask God for love several times a day. He is the only Source of love, for He is Love (1 John 4:16).

**COMMUNION IN THE HAND:** The reverent and proper way to receive Holy Communion in the hand is to place one hand underneath the other as to create a "throne" for the Body of Christ. (St. Cyril of Jerusalem, 4<sup>th</sup> C.) Do not cup your hands, please your hands side by side, or reach out and grab the host. Please review this instruction and parents please communicate this with your children who are receiving Holy Communion.

**BLESSING OF CANDLES:** Holy Mass for the Presentation of the Lord and the Blessing of Candles will be on Tuesday, February 2 at 6:30 AM. Bring your devotional candles from home to be blessed.

**BLESSING OF THROATS:** Holy Mass for the Feast of St. Blaise, Martyr and the Blessing of Throats will be on Wednesday, February 3 at 6:30 AM. All are welcome.
