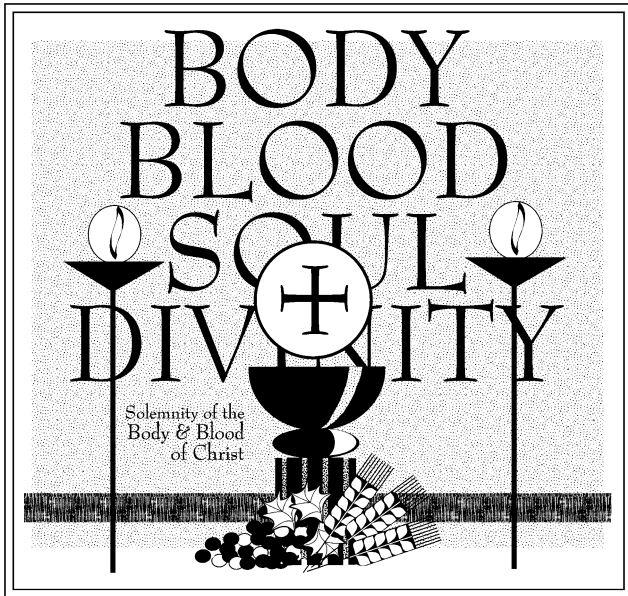


Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Reflection on the Scriptures

"This is My body, which is for you." —1 Corinthians 11:24

Jesus continues to say to each of us: "This is My body" and "This is My blood." Jesus says: "My flesh is real food and My blood real drink" (John 6:55). When we receive Holy Communion, we receive the body and blood, soul and divinity of Jesus.

Most of us reading this believe in the miracle of Jesus' eucharistic presence. However, we may need to cry out to Jesus: "I believe. Help my lack of faith!" (Mark 9:24, our translation) How deeply do we believe in the Eucharist? How do our lives answer this question? Do you make any sacrifices necessary to receive Jesus daily in Communion? Would you walk twenty miles to go to Mass? Would you give up the possibility of having grandchildren by encouraging your only child to be a priest? Would you risk your life to receive Communion in Muslim countries or China? Do you make visits to the Blessed Sacrament? Do you try to make frequent holy hours before the Blessed Sacrament?

Pope St. John Paul II called us to be "intensely eucharistic" (*Towards the Third Millennium*, 55). If this book, *One Bread, One Body*, has been used by the Lord to deepen your faith in the Eucharist, please tell us and we will be forever thankful for the Lord letting us be part of His wondrous works. Praise our eucharistic Lord forever!
