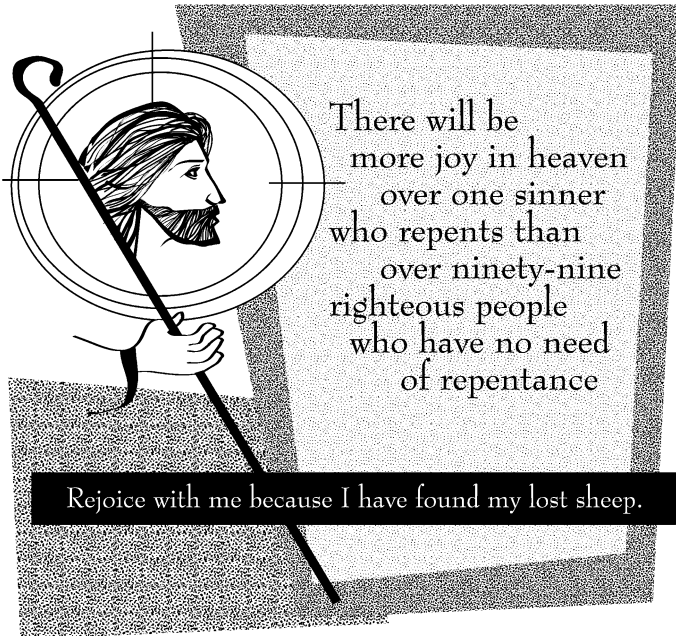


**Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection on the Scriptures

"Why, O Lord, should Your wrath blaze up against Your own people?" —Exodus 32:11

Why, O Lord, should Your wrath blaze up against Your own people?" —Exodus 32:11 The prodigal son felt that he no longer belonged in his father's family after what he had done (Luke 15:18, 21). His older brother agreed with him (see Luke 15:30). However, the prodigal son's father would hear none of this. He spoke of the prodigal son as "this son of mine" (Luke 15:24).

"Once you were no people, but now you are God's people" (1 Peter 2:10). We belong to God (Romans 14:8). We are a people peculiarly His own (Deuteronomy 26:18). He created and redeemed us. "You are not your own. You have been purchased, and at a price" (1 Corinthians 6:19-20). We are doubly owned by God.

Acknowledge that you belong to God. Rejoice to be owned by the all-powerful Creator and the all-loving Redeemer. Every day, pray and say with Paul: "I have been crucified with Christ, and the life I live now is not my own; Christ is living in me" (Galatians 2:19-20). You belong to Him alone.
