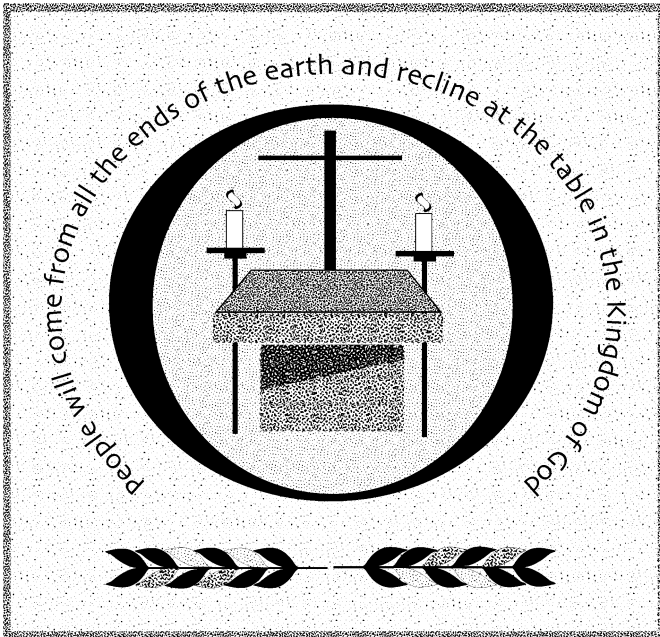


**Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time  
August 21, 2016**



**Reflection on the Scriptures**

Lord, are they few in number who are to be saved?" —Luke 13:23

Jesus taught: "The gate that leads to damnation is wide, the road is clear, and many choose to travel it. But how narrow is the gate that leads to life, how rough the road, and how few there are who find it!" (Matthew 7:13-14) Jesus seems to have said that only a few people are saved from damnation. If this is a correct interpretation, our future is terrifying.

To make sure he was understanding Jesus correctly, "someone asked Him, 'Lord, are they few in number who are to be saved?' " (Luke 13:23) Jesus did not answer that question exactly; instead, He stated that many will try to come into His kingdom and be unable (Luke 13:24). Jesus also declared that eating and drinking with Him and having heard His teachings do not assure us of salvation (Luke 13:26-27). "Some who are last will be first and some who are first will be last" (Luke 13:30).

How can we be saved? We are saved only by God's grace (Ephesians 2:7ff). What must we do to be saved? (Acts 16:30) "Believe in the Lord Jesus" (Acts 16:31). Give Jesus your whole life and "work with anxious concern to achieve your salvation" (Philippians 2:12). Believe in Jesus, the Savior, now.
