**Reflection on the Scriptures**

"I love You, O Lord, my Strength." —Psalm 18:2

Jesus revealed that the two greatest commandments were about loving God and our neighbor (Matthew 22:37-39). Jesus maintained that His mission was to show us the Father's love (John 15:9). He commanded us to love even our enemies (Matthew 5:44). Jesus said that we would be recognized as His disciples because of our "love for one another" (John 13:35). Finally, Jesus laid down His life for us when He died on the cross. "There is no greater love than this" (John 15:13).

The first Christians began to understand Jesus' life of love. They came to realize that:

- God the Father "so loved the world that He gave His only Son" (John 3:16).
- "Love never fails" (1 Corinthians 13:8).
- Without love, we are nothing (1 Corinthians 13:2).
- "Love covers a multitude of sins" (1 Peter 4:8).
- Love is greater than even faith or hope (1 Corinthians 13:13).
- "The love of God has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit" (Romans 5:5).

Finally, the early Church came to the awesome conclusion that "God is Love, and he who abides in Love abides in God, and God in him" (1 John 4:16; see 1 John 4:8). Love Love Himself.
