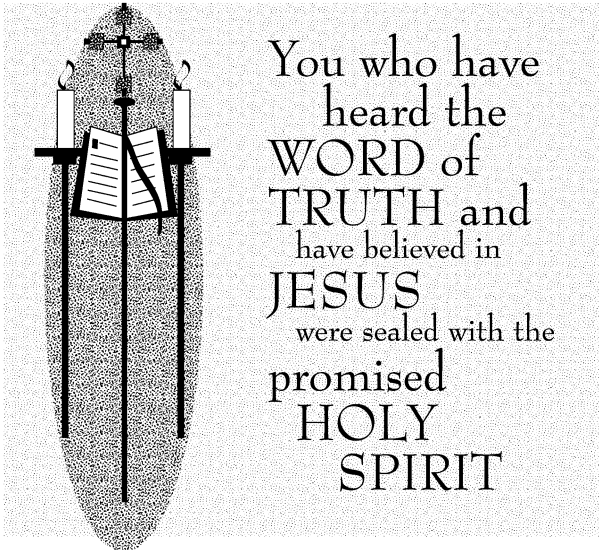


**15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Reflection on the Scriptures**

"Praised be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ." —Ephesians 1:3

Before we were created, the Lord destined us to "praise His glory" (Ephesians 1:12). Our bodies are not ideal for thinking, working, or running. Our human limitations are obvious when we forget information, stumble over our words, stumble over our feet, or get tired. However, our bodies are tailor-made to praise God. From our renewed minds (see Romans 12:2), singing tongues, praying lips, open hearts, raised hands, to our dancing feet — we are created to praise God always and forever.

Our greatest praise of God is Eucharistic worship. At Mass, Jesus, the eternal High Priest, is not only the Object of our praises but also the Leader of our praise and worship to the Father and in the Holy Spirit. Through, with, and in Jesus we share at Mass in the heavenly praises offered by the angels and saints to the Holy Trinity.
