These safety guidelines are an accompaniment to our Religious Education Family Handbook, 2021 – 2022 school year. Although there is no guarantee that ROL can prevent anyone from falling ill as students return to classes, efforts of prevention and attention and care for one another will help provide added measures of safety to our campus. All members of our catechist staff are fully vaccinated and adhere to the policies and procedures as outlined by current guidelines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Hawaii Department of Health (HDOH) and the Diocese of Honolulu.

**PARENT & STUDENT GUIDANCE**

HEALTH	SAFETY
<p>A student* will not be allowed to attend RE classes with any of the following symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Vaccinations are strongly encouraged for those that are eligible.</b></li> <li>• Fever (100 degrees F or higher)</li> <li>• Persistent cough</li> <li>• Congestion, runny nose (non-allergy related)</li> <li>• Stomach ache, vomiting or diarrhea</li> <li>• Rash/sores on the body that appear infected</li> <li>• Contagious sickness</li> </ul>	<p>Families are to conduct a “wellness” (left side column) check prior to coming to class, assessing if it is safe for their child and family to come to ROL.</p> <p>Please call your child’s Catechist should your child be absent.</p> <p><b>*IF a child is in school and is observed having symptoms,</b> a parent will be asked to pick up the child within 1-2 hours. A member of our staff will isolate with your child to ensure health and safety of our community members.</p>

**\*Disclosures:**

- i. **Families are required to disclose if their child or anyone in the household has any symptoms of Covid-19, has been tested or tested positive for Covid-19.**
  - **Vaccinated person: Immediate COVID-19 testing required.**  
 Negative – No quarantine. May return to class.  
 Positive – 10 day quarantine. Must secure a negative test, with health clearance, before returning to class.
  - **Unvaccinated person: Immediate COVID-19 testing required.**  
 Negative – 10 day quarantine. **Vaccinations are strongly encouraged for those that are eligible.**  
 Positive - 10 day quarantine. **NO ADMITTANCE TO CLASS,** until negative test results are received. Doctor’s health clearance is required before returning to class.
- ii. **Families are required to disclose out of state travel plans to determine a safe return date to participate in our RE program. Household member that travelled:**
  - **Vaccinated person: Testing within five days upon arrival to Hawaii is required, if symptomatic or exposed.**  
 Negative results –No quarantine. May return to class.  
 Positive results – 10 day quarantine. Must obtain negative results and doctor’s clearance.
  - **Unvaccinated person: Testing within five (5) days upon arrival to Hawaii is required.**  
 Negative results - 10 day quarantine. **Vaccinations are strongly encouraged for those that are eligible.**  
 Positive test – 10 day quarantine. **NO ADMITTANCE TO CLASS,** until negative test results are received. Doctor health clearance is required before returning to class.

Personal protection: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Upon class arrival, the student must wear a face mask (vaccinated or unvaccinated)</li> <li>• Hand sanitizing</li> <li>• Distancing when possible</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face masks are available if needed at any time through your Catechist or in the office.</li> <li>• Face shields are not required.</li> <li>• Hand sanitizing stations are stationed throughout the Pastoral Center and the Church.</li> <li>• Signage is posted throughout the Pastoral Center as a reminder of safety guidelines.</li> </ul>

## CLASSROOMS

Classroom preparations <b>before &amp; after</b> each class: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All touch surface will be sanitized: Door handles, chairs, desks, counter tops and other physical items</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wiping down with sanitizing materials (spray and/or wipe)</li> </ul>
Student safeguards <b>before</b> entering classroom: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face Masks</li> <li>• Hand Sanitizing</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face mask required. Face shield not necessary.</li> <li>• Hand sanitizers and wipes are available upon arrival.</li> <li>• Kleenex tissues, extra face masks will be available when needed. May bring own.</li> <li>• Personal water bottle recommended.</li> </ul>
Classroom setting: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Catechist</li> <li>• Seating</li> <li>• Text books &amp; Activity workbooks</li> <li>• Classroom resources</li> <li>• Classroom ventilation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Catechist(s) shall face the children, 6 feet apart.</li> <li>• Children will be facing in one direction, 3 feet apart.</li> <li>• Each child will have their own text books and workbooks to use. All should be labeled.</li> <li>• NO SHARED USE: Each student to have their own box containing pencils, erasers and crayons or markers.</li> <li>• Open all windows to allow maximum ventilation.</li> </ul>

Student gathering and socializing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Activities</li> <li>• Celebration, snacks</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student activities will be kept to 6 feet distancing.</li> <li>• <b>NO SNACK, FOOD INSIDE CLASSROOM.</b>                Birthday, snack items can be distributed after class, but <b>MUST</b> be pre-packaged for individual use.</li> </ul>

## RESTROOMS

---

HEALTH	SAFETY
Cleanliness and sanitization check: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student use</li> <li>• Hand washing</li> <li>• Signage</li> </ul>	Before, after and during classes. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student one at a time, Catechist monitoring.</li> <li>• Handwashing a <b>MUST</b> before returning to class.</li> <li>• Post in bathrooms proper hand-washing techniques (20 second rule).</li> </ul>
